one goes better; has an appointment at IU on April 21

Norma Johnson - Judi Skonieczny's mother; has a serious foot wound; trying to
improve low blood flow before they can do surgery; she is in the hospital;
they may only need to take 2 toes, instead of above the knee

Terry Huber - Randy Augsburger's cousin has been fighting cancer for the last couple years;
diagnosed with new cancer that is inoperable; he has been given two months. Was home from
hospital for 1 day before going back to ER with a fever; transferred to OSU & waiting to be
cleared of viruses before going into The James. Terry & his family are believers.

Bob Wood, Bernie Horn's brother-in-law; diagnosed with aggressive prostate cancer;
got markers for radiation on 3/20; meets with doctor Thursday & then will
begin his radiation which will be 5 days a week for 9 weeks
