Facts of Psalm 119:
The Psalm was written as an acrostic poem.
22 stanzas (Heb. Alphabet) each letter having 8 verses
The Psalmist was not popular nor his devotion to God's Word. He was surrounded by wickedness. He was harassed by the He experienced sorrow and suffering.
The Psalmist used eight words describing God's Word.
Law = Instruction: Books of Moses 25 x
Law = Regulation (right & wrong) 23 x
Word = from the of God 24 x
Statutes = Testimony: experienced observed 23 x
Commands = God's Orders 22 x
Decrees = Engraved: what's established 21 x
Precepts = Direction desiring response 21 x
Promise = positive future 19 x
This Psalm has three key phrases: "According to your Word" in your Word"
"According to your Promise"
