

The Divided Kingdom

1 & 2 Kings/ Isaiah & Jeremiah

Once Divided Israel didn't want to go into Judah to worship. They set up their own gods (Idolatry)

Soon Judah, at times, followed. *[Depending on the King]*
Sin brings Punishment = Captivity

Five Types of Leadership Roles God used in the Old Testament

<i>Patriarchs</i>	<i>Judges</i>	<i>Priests</i>	<i>Kings</i>	<i>Prophets</i>
<i>Abraham</i>	<i>Deborah</i>	<i>Aaron</i>	<i>Saul</i>	<i>Elijah</i>
<i>Jacob / Israel</i>	<i>Gideon</i>	<i>Eli</i>	<i>David</i>	<i>Jeremiah</i>
<i>Moses</i>	<i>Samson</i>	<i>Samuel</i>	<i>Solomon</i>	<i>Daniel</i>

Differences in the roles:

The ***Patriarchs*** common **man** responded to **God** in obedience.

The ***Judges*** restored **God's** nation when **men** cried out to **God**.

The ***Priests*** represented **man** to **God** by covering sins with sacrifice.

The ***Kings*** ruled **God's** people, **man's** choice / **God's** appointment.

The ***Prophets*** revealed **God's** truths to **man**.
