To Sum up the book of Judges in two *repeated* verses:

*Then the Israelites did evil in the eyes of the Lord . . .
Judges 2:11; 3:7 & 12; 4:1; 6:1; 10:6; 13:1*

*In those days Israel had no king; everyone did as he
saw fit. Judges 17:6 & 21:25*

The book of Judges is divided into three parts:

Causes chapters 1-3

Conditions chapters 3-16

Consequences chapters 17-21

- Saul**
- was looking for his father's donkeys when he was selected as King? 1 Sam 9
 - was anointed King, the Spirit of God came on him in power? (*yet when announced as king he was hiding*) 1 Sam. 10
 - and his son Jonathon, at one point, were the only two in Israel with swords? 1 Sam 13
 - Saul "seemed" to use his spear as his scepter? (*He kept it in his hand.*) 1 Sam. 18:10; 19:9; 22:6; 26:121 & 16

- David (s) ...**
- great-grandmother was Ruth & (Matthew 1)
great-great ... was Rahab the prostitute from Jericho?
 - was anointed the next king before the fight with Goliath? 1 Sam 16
 - fled Jerusalem for a time because of his own son Absalom? 2 Sam. 15

- Solomon ('s)**
- mother was Bathsheba?
He was the 2nd son, the first son, from the affair died. 1 K. 1
 - was visited by the Queen of Sheba? 1 King 10
 - Had 700 wives of noble birth & 300 concubines? 1 King 11
