Personal Concerns / Judge Others / Those Like Me  
or a **Compassionate & \_\_\_\_\_ God.**

*For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.  
Therefore, as God's chosen people, ... clothe yourselves with  
compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with  
each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance  
against someone. ... put on love, which binds them all together in  
perfect unity. Colossians 3:3 & 12-14*
