the major focus is on God.

Commonly, the confessing to God is **limited** to when we're **convinced** we've done wrong. Nehemiah and the people confessed in the reality of who God is!

Creates something out of nothing. v. 6

Chooses and places people & things. v. 7-8

A Witness of our Suffering. v. 9-11

Works against our Oppressors and does Wonders for us.

God...

*D*_____ Psalm 23 / Psalm 139:10

Confirms where we should go. v. 12-11

Communicates what is best and safest for us.

is *D*_____ 2 Peter 3:9

Provides, even when we struggle to follow. v. 15-21

Patient: wanting & waiting for us to repent. v. 28-31

God...

*D*_____ Romans 8:28 & 37

Conquers our enemies. v. 22-25

He brings His promises to Completion.

God...

*D*_____ Prov. 3:12 / Heb. 12:5-6

Corrects us often with Circumstances. v. 26-27

Sometimes Chooses to use our enemies.

is *D*_____ Psalm 85:4

Confession permits us to experience His Faithfulness. v. 32-37

He desires us to Call on Him.
