God-given **L** _____ v. 16

But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

This is how God showed His love among us: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him. 1 John 4:9

God-given **L** _____ v. 2 & 19

Interesting thought: Jesus is talking to Nicodemus about hiding in the darkness at _____. John 19:38-42

But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, His Son, purifies us from all sin. 1 John 1:7

God-given **L** _____ v. 16 & 21

For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in Him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day. John 6:40

... everyone who **believes** may have eternal life in Him." For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever **believes** in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. / For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. Whoever **believes** in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not **believe** stands condemned already because they have not **believed** in the name of God's one and only Son. John 3:15-18
