Lessons from Thorns

L[Weaknesses]
When we <i>can't do</i> what we used to do or what we'd like to do, we say, Come On God! // God asks, "Do you me?"
I sought the LORD, and He answered me; He delivered me from all my fears. ⁵ Those who look to Him are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame. ⁶ This poor man called, and the LORD heard him; He saved him out of all his troubles. Ps 34:4-6

S[Hardships ~ Difficulties]
When we <i>wrestle</i> with things we can't conquer and we say, Come On God! // God says, that is only through me.
The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear and He delivers them. Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in Him. // The righteous person may have many troubles, but the LORD delivers him from them all; Psalm 34:7-8 & 19

P [Insults ~ Persecution]
When we <i>agonize</i> through suffering and/or sorrow saying, Come On God! // God says, I know Because of me, you have hope.
