How Revival Comes Communication is Key

Revival comes through the *personal presence* of the Holy Spirit. The door on earth is opened by _____.

They all joined <u>together</u> <u>constantly</u> <u>in</u> <u>prayer</u>, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers</u>. 1:24

When the day of Pentecost came, they were <u>all together</u> in one place. 2:1

They <u>devoted themselves</u> to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and <u>to prayer</u>. Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. 2:42-43

One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the <u>time</u> <u>of prayer</u>—at three in the afternoon. 3:1

When they heard this, they <u>raised their voices together in prayer</u> to God. "Sovereign Lord," they said, "you made the heavens and the earth and the sea, and everything in them. 4:24

<u>After they prayed</u>, the place where they were meeting was <u>shaken</u>. And they were <u>all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke</u> <u>the word of God boldly</u>. 4:31
