**Q.** WHAT MOVES GOD the Most? **A.** !

## In Our Crippled Condition:

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, so that you through *His poverty might become rich.* 2 Corinthians 8:9

(Jesus) Who, being in very nature God, ... made Himself nothing, ... being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to death--Philippians 2:6-8 even death on a cross!

## Jesus **O**\_\_\_\_\_ Himself to Suffer.

But we see Jesus, ... suffered death, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone. Because He Himself suffered when He was tempted, He is able to Heb. 2:9 & 18 help those who are being tempted.

#### Jesus $V_{\_\_}$ us in spite of our weaknesses. 9:14

He is able to deal gently with those who are ignorant and are going astray, since He Himself is subject to weakness. Heb. 5:2

For the law appoints as high priests men who are weak; but the oath, which came after the law, appointed the Son, who has been *made perfect (complete) forever.* Hebrews 7:28

Jesus *E\_\_\_\_\_\_* our sinful nature. 9:15 *"once for all" Heb.* 7:27; 9:12, 26 (28); 10:2 & 12
